# PACKAGES

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## **Gold**

*2.5 hours*

up to a 2.5 hour session, 3 locations, basic editing, online gallery, digital download rights

## **Silver**

*1.5 hours*

up to a 1.5 hour session, 2 locations, basic editing, online gallery, digital download rights



## **Bronze**

*45 minutes*

up to a 45 minute session, 1 location, basic editing, online gallery, digital download rights





# THE PROCESS

01

## When to book

I would love to get something on the calendar as soon as you know you want to book with me!

02

## How to book

You can book online on my website using the senior tab!

03

## Before the shoot

Choose location(s), outfit(s), and props, (advice on the next page). Communicate with me if you have any questions or concerns.

04

## Gallery

I will deliver an online gallery within three weeks of the photoshoot. You will be able to create favorites lists, order prints online, and download your images.

05

## Editing

All of my packages include basic editing; color, crop, contrast, and exposure. This does not include retouching, but I am happy to do it on a few of your favorites if needed.

## How to pay

Payment is due at the time of the shoot, and I accept Venmo, check, cash or PayPal!



# ADVICE

- 01 Communication**

Communication is key! So let me know if there is a pose or setting that you like/dislike. I'm here to capture your idea of your perfect senior photos.
- 02 Help**

Bring a friend or family member that will help you feel comfortable and relaxed when taking photos. Friends can help make you laugh or check your hair/clothing throughout the shoot!
- 03 Ideas**

Brainstorming ideas or creating a Pinterest board can help when it comes to the day of your shoot.
- 04 Locations**

I recommend choosing location(s) that mean something to you! The best photos happen when people are in their element; a bookstore, on the track, etc. Otherwise, I would pick locations that match the vibe you'd like to portray. If you need help brainstorming though, please reach out!
- 05 Outfits**

I advise people to wear something that makes them feel confident and comfortable! Always bring one outfit that would be good for the yearbook, then show your personality! I don't limit outfits but do recommend that you max it out at two per hour. If you wear blue light glasses or transition lenses, be ready to take them off or wear a different pair of glasses!
- 06 Props**

Include props that can show your personality as well! It also helps people relax in front of the camera!
